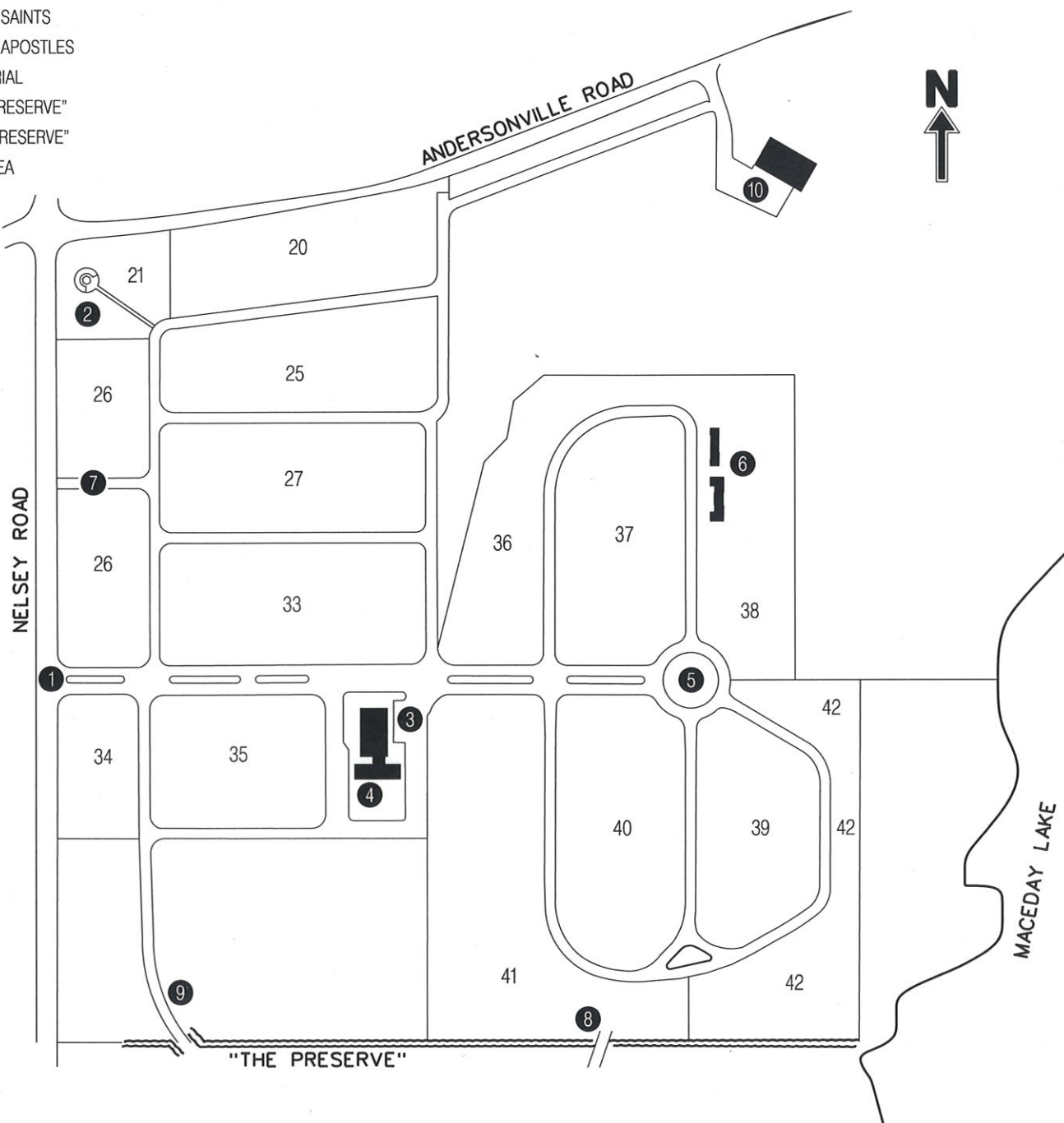

DECORATIONS

1. Planting of live flowers is permitted in the designated area above each headstone and around the upright monument on monument lots. Planting of flowering bushes, shrubs or trees is not permitted.
2. Grave decorations are limited to two fresh cut flower bouquets in a cemetery approved container, placed directly above the grave marker. All artificial decorations will be removed.
3. Flower boxes are not required, but may be used. The flower box must be level with the ground and flush against the headstone, and may be made of wood, metal or plastic. One flower box per grave is permitted with an outside dimensions of 24"Lx10"Wx6"D.
4. Wreaths, Grave Blankets, Crosses or Topiary Balls made of evergreen boughs may be placed on the graves from November 15th through March 15th. Decorations cannot exceed the boundaries of the grave.
5. Seasonal cleanup of winter decorations on the grounds and in all mausoleums begins March 1st. Fall cleanup of the grounds begins October 1st.
6. Grave blankets, wreaths, and mausoleum arrangements may be purchased at the cemetery office or online at www.mtelliott.com.
7. The cemetery management reserves the right to landscape each section according to a carefully prepared landscape plan.

MEMORIALS

1. Grave markers to be placed in this cemetery must be made of granite and will be set flush with the Earth's surface. Markers must be flat on top and bottom with sawed sides and top edges pencil round at a minimum of ¼ inch.
2. Monuments will be permitted only on lots designated as a monument site.
3. All carvings, inscriptions, epitaphs, etc., for markers and monuments must be approved by the cemetery.
4. There is a setting and maintenance fee charged on all memorials and a foundation fee for all upright monuments.
5. Attachments are not permitted on any memorial.
6. Memorials and monuments may be purchased at the cemetery office.

SELECTED REGULATIONS

The regulations listed above are intended to preserve and protect the Rights of Burial for all. The management sympathizes when these rules may interfere with individual wishes. Please consider the rights of all lot owners. These regulations are not complete and therefore any questions regarding items not specifically covered herein must be approved by the cemetery office. New regulations may be adopted as management deems necessary and shall apply to all rights of burial whether purchased prior or subsequent to their adoption.

Unleashed pets are not permitted at any time.

Transfer of burial rights must be processed at the cemetery office.

All work on grave repair, removals, and memorials will be completed in a fashion as to allow for the orderly operation of the cemetery.
