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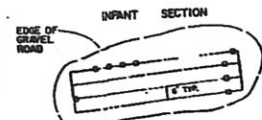

CITY OF FLUSHING CEMETERY RULES

1. No trees or shrubbery to be planted on lots without permission of caretaker.
2. No rose bushes of any kind to be planted.
3. Flowers and urns to be placed in beds not to exceed 18 inches behind markers. (East side)
4. Natural flowers and silk flowers will be permitted but must be placed in pots or containers not to exceed 18" behind marker.
5. No parking of cars on grassed areas. Parking on gravel drives only.
6. No wooden boxes to be used for burials.
7. No curbing of lots or other cement work allowed, except proper foundations for monuments and markers to be installed by the caretaker.
8. All memorials must be approved materials.
9. Any cemetery lot conveyance made within one year of purchase to a non-resident of the City, the non-resident must pay the additional cost to the City.
10. One (1) week before cleanup, there will be an advertisement in the local paper notifying people to collect the items they may want to keep.

CITY OF FLUSHING CEMETERY

- THE CITY WILL ALLOW ONLY ONE CREMATION BURIAL PER GRAVE SITE.
- INFANT BURIALS IN BABYLAND HAS A MAXIMUM CASKET SIZE OF 24" X 36". WHEN A VAULT IS USED AND THE MEASUREMENTS EXCEED THE 24" WIDTH, TWO GRAVE SPACES MUST BE PURCHASED.
- TENT SERVICE IS PROVIDED IN THE REGULAR CEMETARY WITH THE CURRENT OPENING AND CLOSING FEES.
- NO TENT SERVICE PROVIDED FOR CREMATION OR BABYLAND
- HOLIDAY SHALL MEAN HOLIDAYS AS RECOGNIZED UNDER THE CITY EMPLOYEE AGREEMENT.
- WOODEN CASKETS REQUIRE A CEMENT VAULT: FIBER GLASS CASKETS DO NOT REQUIRE VAULTS.
- MARKER FOOTINGS: .18 CENTS PER SQUARE INCH.
IMPORTANT: BABYLAND markers can be NO bigger than 20" x 12"
CREMATION section markers 24" x 12"
REGULAR section markers 36" x 24"
- CREMATION LOTS ARE 24" x 24"
- ALL PLANTINGS TO BE WITHIN 18" OF THE BACK OF THE STONE.
 - NOTHING WITH THORNS
 - *EXCEPTION: Cremation Section -planting only 6" behind the stone (to east of stone)*

Sec. 95.01. Title.

This chapter shall be known, and may be cited as the municipal cemetery chapter.
(Code 1967, § 3-401)

Sec. 95.02. Definitions.

For the purpose of this chapter the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

Municipal cemetery or Cemetery. The municipal cemetery.

Superintendent. The superintendent of the municipal cemetery.
(Code 1967, § 3-402)

Sec. 95.03. Location of markers or monuments.

All markers or monuments shall be permitted only at the head of the grave site.
(Code 1967, § 3-404)

Sec. 95.04. Rules for cemetery.

- (a) No trees or shrubbery shall be planted on lots without the permission of the caretaker.
- (b) No rose bushes of any kind shall be planted.

- (c) Natural flowers will be permitted to be placed in beds not to exceed eighteen (18) inches behind the marker. Silk flowers will also be permitted and they must be placed in a pot or container not to exceed eighteen (18) inches behind the marker.
 - (d) No parking of cars shall be allowed on grassed areas. Parking shall be on gravel drives only.
 - (e) No wooden boxes shall be used for burials.
 - (f) No curbing of lots or other cement work shall be allowed except for proper foundations for monuments and markers to be installed by the caretaker.
 - (g) All memorials shall be of approved materials.
 - (h) One (1) week prior to the time period set aside for clean-up of cemetery grave sites an advertisement will be placed in the local newspaper to advise citizens of such clean-up period. Individuals will be required to pick up any salvageable wreaths, plastic flowers or ornaments during that period.

Sec. 95.05. Above ground headstones in new sections of cemetery.

Above ground headstones may be placed in the new sections of the cemetery.

Sec. 95.06. Interment.

- (a) No deceased person shall be interred in the cemetery until the superintendent has found that:
 - (1) A burial permit has been obtained as required by law;
 - (2) The lot in which burial is to be made has been fully paid for;
 - (3) The person arranging for the burial has the right to the use of such lot;
 - (4) The lot is not used beyond its capacity; and
 - (5) Proper record is made of the name and age of the deceased person and of the exact location of the grave.

GENERAL REGULATIONS – MUNICIPAL CEMETERY

Sec. 95.07. Single individual in each grave.

It is the city's intent that only the remains of a single individual be placed in each legal plotted grave regardless of method of burial.
(Code 1967, § 3-407)

Sec. 95.08. Procedure for acceptance of monuments.

The department of public works shall not accept any monuments for the cemetery unless the department has a work order requesting a foundation for that particular marker.

Sec. 95.09. Supervision of cemetery.

The care, maintenance, and operation of the municipal cemetery shall be under the supervision and control of the city manager.
(Code 1967, § 3-403)

Sec. 95.10. Superintendent of cemetery; Duties.

- (a) The City Manager or his appointee shall be Superintendent of the cemetery. (Code 1967, § 3-404)
- (b) The Superintendent shall look after and take proper care of the cemetery and see that no lot therein is used or occupied in violation of this chapter or of any rule or regulation promulgated in accordance herewith.
- (c) The Superintendent shall dig graves and properly inter the dead when called upon to do so.
(Code 1967, § 3-406)

Sec. 95.11. Procedure for establishing rules and regulations.

- (a) The City Manager, subject to approval of the Council, shall establish rules and regulations for the use of the cemetery relating to:
 - (1) Subdividing the cemetery into lots;
 - (2) Capacity of each lot;
 - (3) Location of graves;
 - (4) Type of plantings, monuments, and markers that will be permitted for the proper and attractive development of the cemetery;

(5) Conduct in the cemetery; and

(6) Requirements for Burial Vaults.

(b) Such rules and regulations shall, when approved by the City Council, have full force and effect of law, and shall be available to the public at the office of the City Clerk.
(Code 1967, § 3-404)

Sec. 95.12. Lot valuation.

There shall be no discrimination in the sale of lots, on any basis other than as herein provided in Section 95.14.
(Code 1967, § 3-408; Ord. No. 95, 11-12-02)

Sec. 95.13. Method of purchase.

Any person desiring to purchase a particular lot, for the purpose for which it is intended, shall be permitted to do so upon payment of the price fixed for such a lot, or upon making arrangements, according to rules and regulations that may be established in accordance with this chapter for the purchase of such a lot.
(Code 1967, § 3-408)

Sec. 95.14. Cemetery Fees.

(a) The City Council, by resolution, may establish rates and charges for the sale of lots and services including, but not limited to grave opening and closing, installment of marker footings and markers, disinterment and reinterment. The City Council may charge different rates for city residents and non-residents; should a city resident purchase a grave site to be used by a non-resident, the city may charge the difference in rates at the time of burial.

Sec. 95.15. Records of ownership.

The City Clerk shall keep full and complete records of the ownership of all lots in the cemetery, the burial capacity of each lot, sold and unsold, the location of each grave, the names of the persons buried in each grave that has been or shall hereafter be used, and the date of burial of each.
