MEMORIAL DAY

A parade and celebration are held annually on Memorial Day. Members of the VFW is in charge of planning the ceremonies. Small 12" x 18" flags are purchased by the VFW and Groveland Township and placed on each veteran's grave by the Veterans.

Large 3' x 5' flags are placed along the roadways by the VFW and volunteers. These flags are flown on Sunday and Monday of Memorial Day. These flags are purchased by the families of veterans through the Office of Representative Lisa McClain in Washington, D. C.

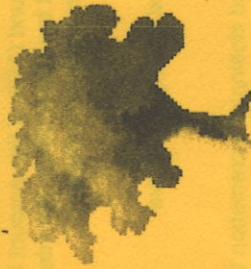

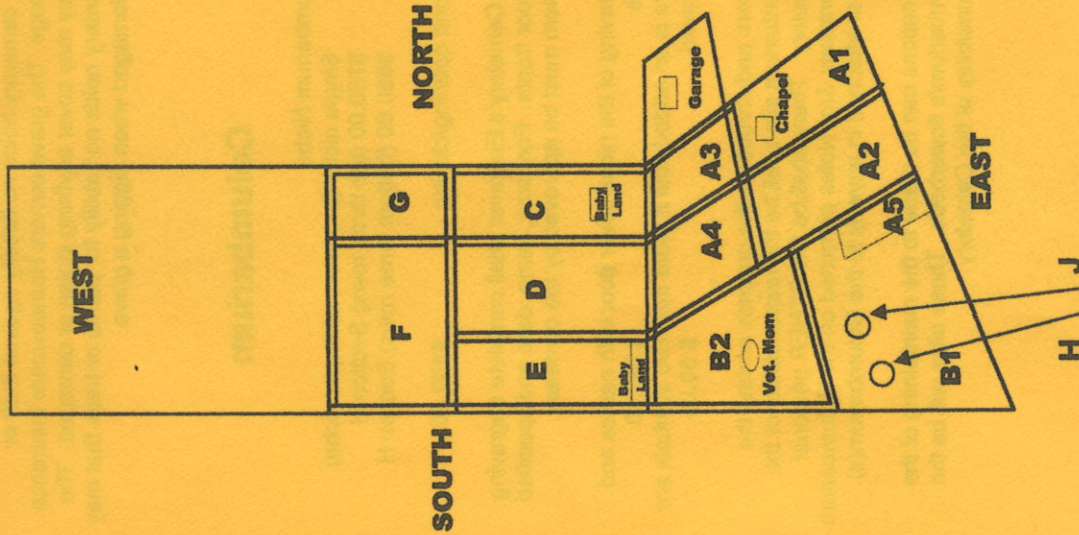


FACTS

The cemetery covers 26 acres, 16 acres developed (2 of which are partially complete), 10 acres in the woods. The cemetery was established in 1867 and reorganized for perpetual care in 1931. Gravestones age back to 1840 when it was used as a private burial ground.

GOVERNMENT

The cemetery is governed by a nine-member board. Meetings are the second Monday of January, April, July, and October. The annual public meeting is the April Meeting.

Single gravesite, payable within two years. If not ownership will return to the Cemetery Association without refund (15% of this amount is kept in an endowment trust fund, which the interest is used for the upkeep of the cemetery.) *

NOTE: Two interments per gravesite are allowed. One full burial and one cremation or two cremations.

There will be no burial or stones set on a gravesite until purchase of the lot/Columbarium Niche is complete. All gravestone foundations shall be installed by Ortonville Cemetery personnel. Veteran markers are \$100.00 flat rate installed and foundations are \$175.00 base fee plus .50 per square inch. Saturday funerals and cremations will incur an additional fee of \$150.00 **Sunday & Holiday charges are double the standard opening and closing prices.**

The cemetery holds no liability against theft or damage. The grave owners Homeowners Insurance Policy may cover anything stolen or damaged. The cemetery holds no liability for plants or trees that may be damaged when digging a grave.

The Cemetery's Engraver shall complete engraving on door fronts. Font size, name, date and specified emblem must be approved by the cemetery.

Flowers and shrubs on the grounds around the columbarium site shall be the responsibility of the Cemetery. There shall be NO OTHER personal decorations &/or Notes permitted on the Columbarium site, or attached in anyway to the Columbarium(s).

**Donations can be made to the maintaining of the columbarium/s flowerbeds. These sites will be the responsibility of the Cemetery.

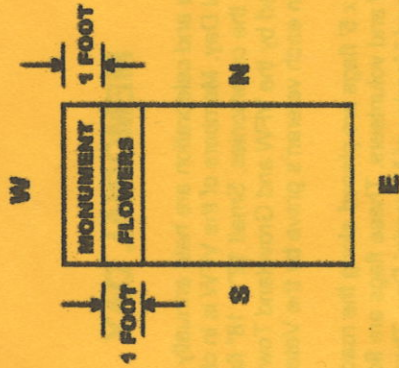
CARE OF GRAVES

Monuments and plants may be placed on grave sites but only under regulations approved by the trustees and may be placed only on the west 24" of each lot. No trees or bushes to be planted on graves and will be removed without notice. There shall be nothing set on the remaining area of the grave site with the exception of a Military plaque buried at ground level. (See below)

All Artificial flowers must be placed in a container. Winter decorations, such as grave blankets and wreaths, should be removed by March 10.

Flowerbeds, must be planted on the east side of the memorial and no more than the width of your lot and not more than 24 inches from the back of the headstone. Landscaping with stones, lava rock and or fences is not permitted. No benches are allowed unless used as a headstone.

There are no Exceptions.



"GRAVE"

Any request to place lawn ornaments, statues, urns or any other decoration must be presented in writing for the approval of the Board of Directors. Any other decorations which become broken, deteriorated or in any way unsightly, will be removed without notice. Grave markers and monuments must be authorized material only. Signs, banners, balloons, billboard, poster board, whirlybirds, solar lights or wood structures of any kind are not permitted. All holiday decorations will be removed three days after the holiday when the holiday falls between April 1 and November 1. Shepherd hooks misused will be removed.

Spring clean up will be on or about The 1st of April each year. Anything you may wish to save should be removed by that date. No person shall leave refuse on the grounds, except in receptacles provided. No person shall break, destroy or deface any tree, shrubs and/or other property of the association or its members. No person shall cause any damage while on the grounds. Any violators will be required to pay for the damage and/or prosecuted under the Provisions of Michigan Law.
