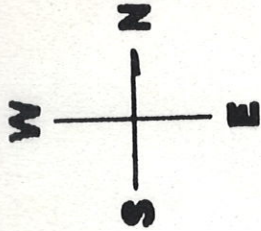


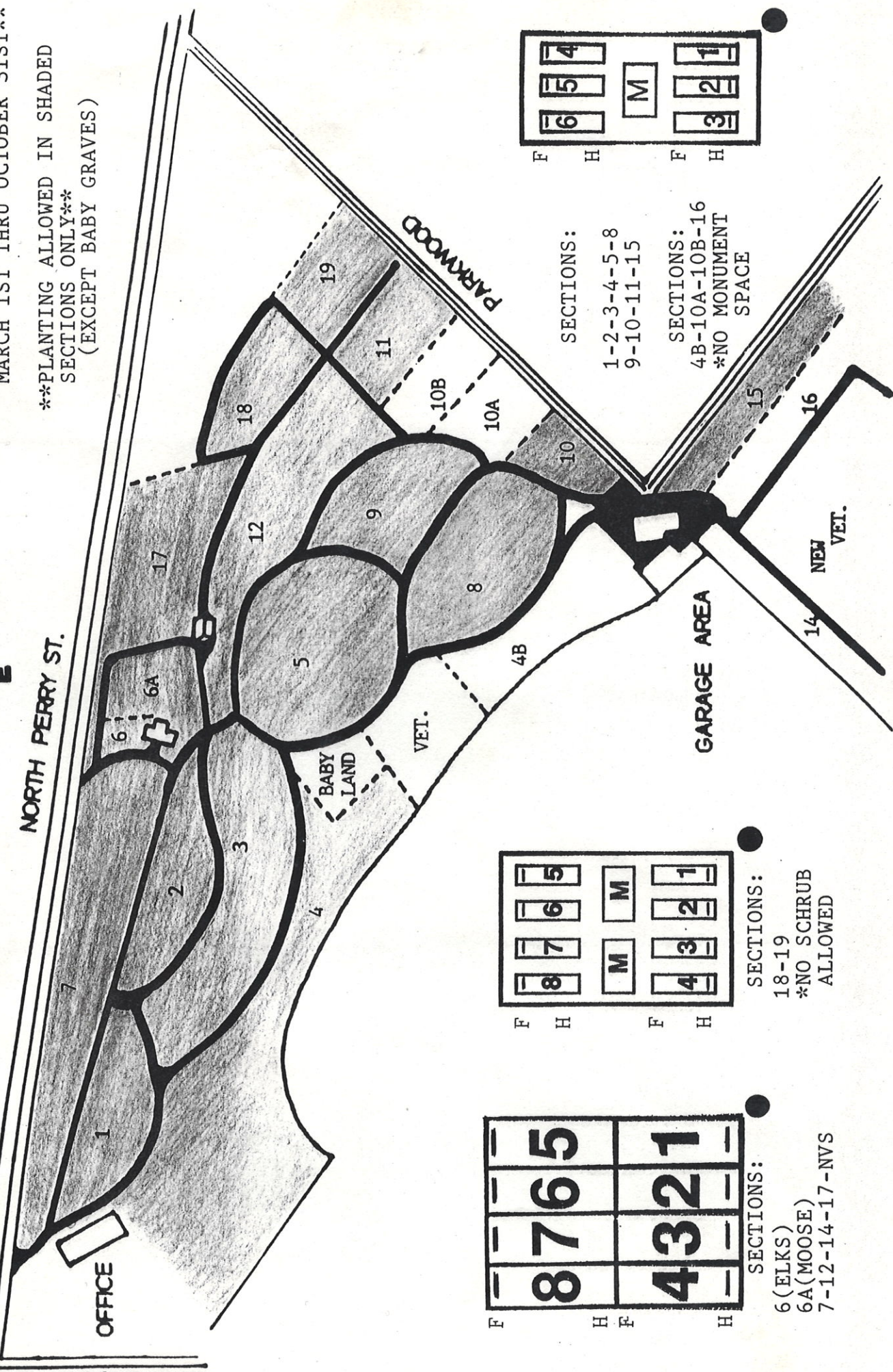

## EXCERPTS from RULES and REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations were adopted by the Board of Directors of Perry Mount Park Cemetery and Crematory. The Property Manager shall be held responsible for the enforcement of all such rules and regulations to ensure and maintain a clean and safe environment for families, visitors and staff.

1. **Between November 1st and the following March 1st** artificial flowers, blankets, wreaths, ornaments, wooden crosses, etc are permitted on any grave. All decorations will be picked up and disposed of by Cemetery Staff beginning March 1st.
2. **Between March 1st and May 1st** the Cemetery Staff will be doing spring clean-up. **NOTHING IS ALLOWED ON ANY GRAVE DURING THIS TIME** except fresh cut flowers in a spike vase.
3. Between May 1st and October 1st annual plants may be planted on the grave if interred in a planting section. (refer to blue shaded sections of the cemetery map). **PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS** (refer to diagram below).
4. Fresh cut flowers are permitted on any grave throughout the year. Spike vases are furnished by the Cemetery and are available outside of the Cemetery office.
5. Flags are permitted on any grave all year round.
6. Summer Holiday Rules: (Holidays are defined as Easter Sunday, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day, Independence Day and Labor Day). You may place artificial flowers, potted plants and decorations of your choice on the grave one (1) day before the holiday. These items will remain on the grave thru and including the third day after the holiday. On the fourth day after the holiday, Cemetery Staff will begin removing and disposing of all holiday decorations.

## NOT ALLOWED:

Perennials (any plant or bush that grows back every year) solar lights, fencing, mulch, stones, brick pavers, landscape edging, wire screens, toys, statues, trellises, tripods, shepherd hooks, pinwheels, architectural objects, or so-called ornaments, food, bottles, cans, pictures, etc.

THESE ARE CONSIDERED INJURIOUS TO THE BEAUTY, DIGNITY AND REPOSE OF THE CEMETERY.

**The Cemetery shall not be liable** for loss or damage caused by an act of nature, thieves, vandals, malicious mischief makers, unavoidable accidents, riot or order of any military or civil authority.
