

HERITAGE GREENS GARDENS

RULES & REGULATIONS

All memorials shall be set on a uniform line as prescribed by Tyrone Memory Gardens to conform with the specific plan of the Garden. All memorials must be of the monument style and at least twenty-four inches in height. A height of seventy-two inches must be approved by the Tyrone Board of Directors. No slants or bevels with or without a granite base will be allowed.

Individual monuments: Cannot exceed thirty-two inches in length and eighteen inches in width. (One grave)

Companion monument: Cannot exceed seventy-two inches in length and eighteen inches in width. (Two graves)

Monuments for three graves cannot exceed one hundred and eight inches in length and twenty-four inches in width.

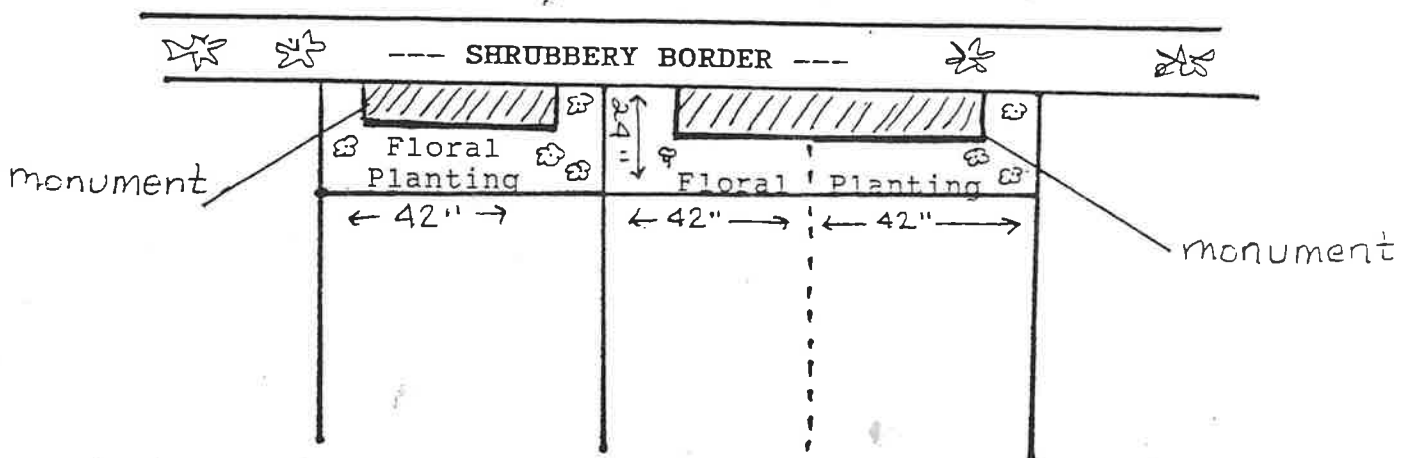
Veteran issued markers must be of bronze, lawn level and placed at the foot of the grave with a wide border foundation. No vases or planting allowed at the marker.

Lettering of identification, verse, carving or attachment of any kind will NOT be allowed on the back of any monument.

A floral bed will be prepared at the time of foundation installation at the request of the family. Floral plants, either annual or perennial (except rose bushes) must be furnished, planted and maintained by the family members.

Planting of any sort is not allowed in the shrubbery border. This area will be maintained by the cemetery.

Planting space allowed for each is forty-two inches in width and twenty-four inches in depth. See below.
